



NYPD QUEST PROGRAM

Dear *Police Officer* Candidate,

Congratulations! The New York City Police Department is planning to hire another class of Police Officers and you may be one of them. Over the next few years many more will be called for a career as one of New York's FINEST.

In order to be considered for appointment, candidates must pass a series of examinations to determine suitability. To further assist out of town candidates, the NYPD has implemented a Quick Efficient Standardized Testing (*QUEST*) Program. This program would allow candidates to do all standardized testing in one visit. A sample *QUEST* session would be as follows:

Day 1: Medical Exam, Fingerprints and Application

Day 2: Psychological Written Exam

Day 3: Oral Psychological, Meet with Investigator

Day 4: Job Standards Test (physical agility test)

(The above is a sample, testing may not be conducted in this particular order)

Any candidate whose visit to New York would require an overnight stay would be eligible for the *QUEST* program.
